Honorable and Wise Planning Commission Members,

I support the idea of upgrading the lighting in Sea Grove Park, however I think that there should be more thought put into the lighting at the location on the E edge of the park where the crosswalk leaves the park and heads across Coast Blvd towards the Post Office. At night it is very difficult to see pedestrians in that crosswalk, especially when heading W on 15th St to then turn N on Coast Blvd. Too many people are out at night wearing dark colors and there is not enough light in that location for them to be safely seen. There was a light in this location many years ago, however the wood rotted and it failed and it was never replaced; it should have been. You have the opportunity to do so now and I hope you will choose to do so.

The design needs to be sensitive to Mike & Janice who live at the NE corner of 15th St & Coast Blvd; perhaps their 2nd floor living area is high enough that replacing the tall light won't be an aggravation for them. Mike has great ideas – perhaps you can ask him for suggestions. He will also be able to weigh in as to whether more light is needed than what is proposed to keep the park a safe location for all to use. It doesn't appear that the proposed lighting will do much for security; it appears to be useful for only lighting the pathways.
