3) **Call to review and vote to approve minutes-** January minutes will be approved at next month's meeting.

4) **Public and oral communications** (non-agenda) –

Nancy Stokes stated that she would like to see a policy regarding individuals sleeping in their cars. Nancy also shared article titled Vision Zero (Wall Street Journal Jan 18, 2019) regarding traffic causing EMS delays. Will be further discussed at March meeting.

5) **Committee selection of Chairperson and Secretary.** Motion made for Robin to assume Chair and Tracy assume secretary for one additional year.

6) **New member selection and committee roster review (expiration dates)-** not discussed

7) **Community Service Updates-** none

8) **Public Works department Update -Joe Bride**

1) Ryan Zellers reported speed survey findings. Survey conducted one week after speed signs installed. Ryan reported the speed survey results and found that most speeds fell within the 85% of posted speed. Committee made unanimous motion to recommend speed recommendation as follows: Decrease speed to 35 mph on roadway Jimmy Durante, segment San Dieguito Road to Camino Del Mar. No change in speed on roadway Camino Del Mar, segment 4th St-Del Mar Heights Road to Carmel Valley Road and public works to install speed feedback sign. Recertify the remaining recommendations.

9) **Southbound Camino Del mar U-Turn alternative, 2800 block, residents within 500 ft notified. Open speaker:**

Ms. Goodman, 2929 Camino del Mar and member of HOA, spoke against U turn alternative. Three additional letters opposing proposal from nearby residents were not in favor of proposal.

Committee Motion made by Robin which recommended Dave Sykes to offer community education including groups who use north beach areas such as the volleyball league. Also add a sign prior to the turn pocket (north of L turn lane) regarding U turn option at 28th street.

10) **Downtown Electric Vehicle Parking recommendation- Clem Brown**

SAB committee on EVS at January meeting recommended 5 spots. Plans for designated parking spots reviewed by committee members.

11) **Shared Mobility Program- Clem Brown** reported that Del Mar will have a one-year pilot program using Gotcha Rides for bike rentals. Rentals are made by app on phone. The bikes are peddle assist. Will use only this vender. Drop off designated bike areas will be enforced by financial penalties. Will go to City Council for final approval for pilot program. Solana Beach, Encinitas, Carlsbad, Oceanside have partnerships with Gotcha Rides. This vender was picked on certain criteria. The pilot will be one year. No scooters in this pilot. Committee was disappointed to hear that the city does not get ant revenue. Clem stated that the city does not put in any money to start program.

12) **11 Street Cobble Curve, residents within 500 feet notified. - Joe Bride**

Joe stated that 10th and 11th street residents were notified. No red dots or letters received regarding this matter. Joe cut back vegetation opening pathway more. Committee group made motion to consider matter complete. Ken requested that trail maps be provided in town. Joe stated he will follow up on that request.

13) **Ongoing Item= Streetscape Segment 1 Camino Del mar, 9th Street to Plaza, striping/Parking Plan- Joe Bride.** Will be discussed at March meeting.

14) **Oversized/Recreational Vehicles in Residential Zone, Status Update- Robin Crabtree**

Robin made a motion for Staff to Review_current ordinances regarding sleeping in cars overnight. Staff and city manager to review.
