

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-30

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DEL MAR, CALIFORNIA, REQUESTING THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO TO CONSOLIDATE A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 6, 2018, WITH THE STATEWIDE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE DATE PURSUANT TO SECTION 10403 OF THE ELECTIONS CODE

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Del Mar, California, called a General Municipal Election to be held on November 6, 2018, for the purpose of the election of two (2) Members of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the General Municipal Election be consolidated with the Statewide General Election to be held on the same date and that, within the City, the precincts, polling places and election officers of the two (2) elections be the same, and that the County Elections Department of the County of San Diego canvass the returns of the General Municipal Election and that the election be held in all respects as if there were only one (1) election.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DEL MAR DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That pursuant to the requirements of Section 10403 of the Elections Code, the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego is hereby requested to consent and agree to the consolidation of a General Municipal Election with the Statewide General Election on Tuesday, November 6, 2018, for the purpose of the election of two (2) Members of the City Council.

SECTION 2. That the County Election Department is authorized to canvass the returns of the General Municipal Election. The election shall be held in all respects as if there were only one (1) election, and only one (1) form of ballot shall be used. The election will be held and conducted in accordance with the provisions of law regulating the statewide election, pursuant to section 10418 of the Elections Code.


SECTION 3. That the Board of Supervisors is requested to issue instructions to the County Elections Department to take any and all steps necessary for the holding of the consolidated election including the procurement and furnishing of any and all official ballots, notices, printed matter and all supplies, equipment and paraphernalia that may be necessary in order to properly and lawfully conduct said election, with the exception that the Administrative Services Director/City Clerk of the City of Del Mar shall cause the publication of all notices that are indicated as the responsibility of the City Clerk in the Election Calendar for said election.

SECTION 4. That the City of Del Mar recognizes that additional costs will be incurred by the County by reason of this consolidation and agrees to reimburse the County for those costs.

SECTION 5. That the Administrative Services Director/City Clerk is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this Resolution with the Board of Supervisors and the County Elections Department of the County of San Diego.

SECTION 6. That the Administrative Services Director/City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original Resolutions.
