An application has been received from local artist, Maily Morhous, to donate to the City two bronze sculptures proposed to be placed on two City benches along Camino Del Mar. One of the benches is proposed in front of the library at 1309 Camino Del Mar to include a sculpture entitled “Baby Boomers Google”. The other bench is proposed to be located in front of the Del Mar Visitors Association (DMVA) at 1104 Camino Del Mar with a sculpture entitled “Empty Dreams”. The benches are proposed to be a sandstone material measuring 18 inches tall, 24 inches deep, and 6 feet long

In accordance with the Public Art Approval Process and the Public Art Policy, the Art Advisory Committee considered the application on May 22, 2019 and voted that the art meets community standards and can proceed through the approval process. Because this project is proposed to be permanently installed it will require a recommendation from the Design Review Board prior to final Council approval.
