**Exception

1. The applicant or authorized representative must be present in order to ensure action by the Commissioners.
2. Applicants should check the agenda posted at City Hall 72 hours prior to the scheduled meeting.
3. Applicants shall limit their presentations to 10 minutes or less. Other speakers shall limit their presentations to 3 minutes or less.
4. Members of the public shall not address the Planning Commission regarding Administrative Hearing items. Applicants or appellants may address the Commissioners only if requested to do so by the Planning Commission.
5. Meeting will end at 11:00 p.m. unless extended by a majority vote of the Commissioners. If all the items on the agenda are not heard, the remaining items will be heard the following Tuesday at **Del Mar TV Channel 24** located at 240 10th Street.
6. Any item on the agenda may, at the Commissioner's discretion, be placed on the Consent Calendar at the beginning of the meeting. Any member of the public may remove an item from the Consent Calendar. If you have a concern and wish to present information to the PC on any item, you must be present at the beginning of the meeting or write a letter to the PC prior to the meeting.
7. The City of Del Mar does not discriminate on the basis of disability. If you have special needs because of a disability, which makes it difficult for you to participate in the Planning Commission meetings, please contact the City Clerk at 1050, Camino del Mar, or call (858) 755-9313, so the City can make arrangements to accommodate your disability.
8. This notice will be the only written notice sent. Items, which are continued by the PC from one PC meeting to another "time certain" meeting date, will not be re-noticed through the mail.
9. Final action by the Planning Commission may be appealed to the City Council accompanied by a \$100 filing fee within 10 working days. The action is not final until the end of the appeal period, or, if appealed, the end of the City Council reviews.
10. Under California Government Code Sec. 65009, if you challenge the nature of the proposed action in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City of Del Mar at, or prior to, the public hearing.
