RE: North Torrey Pines Bridge over the Railroad located on the southern City boundary

Construction Traffic Update:

The installation of the bat exclusion devices for the purpose of protecting resident bats from construction harm will be complete by January 28.

This work requires the use of extensive construction traffic controls and flagmen as traffic will be narrowed to one lane across the bridge each evening.

Traffic message boards are in place, warning drivers of the impending work and reminding all to "Slow for the Cone Zone". Please observe all warning devices and traffic controls for the duration of the project.

Pedestrians are not to use the bridge or cross the railroad tracks in the area of the bridge. Please follow posted detour route.
