**ITEM 1: City Response to COVID-19 and Other Potential Actions to be Considered**

Council questions and discussion focused on a desire to support the business community by readopting the urgency ordinances and use of the word "encourage" in the proposed resolution.

The majority of the Council did not express support for staff to return with a future agenda item related to consideration of a vaccine mandate for private businesses.

**INCREASE IN TEMPORARY COMMERCIAL SIGNAGE IN ALL COMMERCIAL ZONES.” AND TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO TAKE THE FOLLOWING ACTIONS TO BE IN EFFECT UNTIL SEPTEMBER 30, 2022: EXTEND THE MARCH 31, 2022 EXPIRATION DATES FOR ALL COVID-RELATED PERMITS ISSUED INCLUDING TEMPORARY ENCROACHMENT PERMITS AND TEMPORARY USE PERMITS; EXTEND THE TEMPORARY ALLOWANCE OF TWO A-FRAME SIGNS PER BUSINESS; EXTEND PROVISIONS FOR USE OF ON-STREET PARKING FOR DINING OR OTHER USES; CONTINUE THE TEMPORARY STREAMLINED REVIEW PROCESS FOR COMMERCIAL A-FRAME SIGNAGE TEMPORARILY LOCATED IN THE RIGHT-OF-WAY ADJACENT TO ALL COMMERCIAL ZONES; EXTEND THE ONE-HOUR EXTENSION OF ALCOHOL SALES, SERVICE, AND CONSUMPTION FOR ANY RESTAURANT WITH AN APPROVED SIDEWALK CAFÉ PERMIT. 
