5. **Committee Discussion Items:** Del Mar Plaza Parking Management Plan Status Update: Matt Bator presented the 9 month Parking Management Plan (PMP) memo, followed by a Q&A discussion from the committee. Gina Shoelen, property manager of the Del Mar Plaza, presented data related to bike parking and the increase of bike parking spaces, updated employee parking data, a discussion of ride share drop off, the Go Green Initiative and updated car counts for the weekends January through March 2022.

Discussion topics included ride share parking and 20 minute drop off zone along with loading zone off 15th Street.

Motion: TPAC unanimously recommended to the City of Del Mar to start the process of adding the 15th Street loading zone to the work plan.

Motion: TPAC unanimously recommend that a pilot program for the 20 minute parking spot by the Del Mar Plaza to be converted to a hybrid spot of 20 minute and ride share drop off for the next 3 months with a report back to TPAC at the 12 month update including any adverse impacts (and mitigations), any alleviating and improvements with data including complaints, number of citations and accident information.

Del Mar Plaza Paid Parking Program Amendment. Discussion topics included employee parking, rate increase comparisons, city of Del Mar requirements for validation and employee parking and comments by one attendee who resides on Zuni and raised negative neighborhood impact. Matt Bator collected comments and will forward them to the appropriate City agencies.
