NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on Wednesday, the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of October, 2025, at 6 p.m., (or as soon thereafter as practicable) in the City of Del Mar Town Hall, 1050 Camino del Mar, Del Mar, California, the Design Review Board will conduct a public hearing on the following:

**Description:** A request for *Design Review and Coastal Development Permits* to remodel the exterior of an existing one-story residence with an attached garage to include: construction of a 753 square-foot, one-story addition; modifications to windows and doors; increasing the height and modifying the design of existing roof elements; installation of new exterior lighting; and installation of an air conditioner condenser at the north side of the home.

*Note: This project is located in the Coastal Commission's appeals jurisdiction.*

**Public Testimony:** Those desiring to be heard in favor of or in opposition to this item will be given an opportunity to do so by participating in Design Review Board meetings by addressing the Design Review Board for up to three minutes or by submitting a written comment. Please submit a completed "Speaker Slip", including the item number you wish to speak on, to the Planning Staff prior to the announcement of the agenda item. The forms are located near the door at the rear of the Meeting Room. When called to speak, please approach the podium and state your name for the record.

**Written Comments:** Members of the public can participate in the meeting by submitting a written red dot comment via email to [planning@delmar.ca.us](mailto:planning@delmar.ca.us). The deadline to submit written comments is 12 p.m. on the day of the meeting and the subject line of your email should clearly state the agenda item you are commenting on.

Under California Government Code 65009, if you challenge the nature of the proposed action in Court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or written correspondence delivered to the City at, or prior to, the public hearing.
