Del Mar Bluffs 5 Stabilization Project

- **6th Street – 8th Street:** Crews will be doing night work from **Sunday, October 5 – Thursday, October 17.**
 - Expect construction-related noise, required backup alarms from vehicles, and bright lights used to illuminate work areas.
- **10th Street – 11th Street:** Crews will be performing drainage ditch construction through **October 2025**, which will partially limit access to the railroad right-of-way. Temporary fencing will be in place during the work to keep people safe.
 - **11th Street:** Crews will be staging equipment and accessing the project area. Parking will be limited on this street through **Monday, October 27.**
- **13th Street – Sea Grove Park:** Crews will be grading along the bluffs. Crews will also be doing night work from **Sunday, October 5 – Tuesday, October 6 & Sunday, October 12 – Tuesday, October 14.**
- **Sea Cliff Park:** The southern section is closed **until mid-2026** for construction.
- **Beach:** Periodic work near the seawalls along the project area will take place through **summer 2026.**

LOSSAN Rail Realignment Project

SANDAG is conducting geotechnical testing in several locations within the cities of Del Mar and San Diego to learn more about the underground soil structure. Crews may begin marking the road where utilities are located near testing sites. [Learn more about the project.](#)

- Work will continue near the intersection of Seaview and Luzon Avenues.
- Work will begin at the following sites:
 - Adjacent to the rail track at Wye in the NCTD right-of-way.
 - The turnaround adjacent to Coast to Crest Trail
 - Near the intersection of Pine Needles Drive and Hidden Pines Lane
