Del Mar Bluffs 5 Stabilization Project

- **Coast Boulevard to 13th Street and 8th to 9th Street:** There will be night work from **Sunday night, December 7 to Tuesday morning December 10.** Expect noise from construction equipment, backup alarms, and bright lights along the railroad right-of-way.
- **Sea Cliff Way – 4th Street:** The walking trail in this area will be temporarily closed for improvements. The trail should be reopened before the end of 2025.
- **Sea Cliff Park:** The southern section is closed **until mid-2026** for construction.
- **Beach:** Periodic work near the seawalls along the project area will take place through **summer 2026.**

From **Sunday night, December 7 through the morning of Tuesday, December 9,** construction crews will be doing weekend and nighttime bluff stabilization work in the railroad right-of-way between **13th Street and Coast Boulevard** and between **8th Street and 9th Street.**

LOSSAN Rail Realignment Project

SANDAG is conducting geotechnical testing in several locations within the cities of Del Mar and San Diego to learn more about the underground soil structure. Crews may begin marking the road where utilities are located near testing sites. [Learn more about the project.](#)

- Work will continue at the following locations:
 - Dirt lot off Crest Road
 - Near the intersection of Del Mar Heights Road and Durango Drive
 - Sorrento Valley Road near the I-5 knoll
- Work will begin at the following locations:
 - Portofino Drive near Portofino Circle
 - Sorrento Valley Road and Park and Ride Lot
