Two people have been arrested on suspicion of trespassing on railroad property near Del Mar.

On Friday, January 9, 2026, around 5:00 p.m., deputies from the North Coastal Sheriff's Station received multiple calls about two individuals that were seen on top of a northbound Coaster train as it was in transit toward Del Mar.

Deputies immediately responded to the scene. By the time deputies arrived, the two individuals had already climbed off the train and left the area.

A search of the area was conducted after deputies were given descriptions of the two individuals. During the investigation, one individual was located in the 200 block of S. Coast Highway 101 in Solana Beach. The second individual was located in the 300 block of S. Cedros Avenue in Solana Beach.

Both individuals admitted to riding on top of the train. They were subsequently arrested for trespassing on railroad property. No injuries were reported.

The San Diego County Sheriff's Office wants to remind the public that individuals who engage in trespassing or dangerous behavior around railroad equipment/tracks pose serious safety risks to themselves and others.
