EXPLANATION OF EXEMPTIONS OF WATER CAPACITY CHARGES FOR SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENCES WITH FIRE SPRINKLER SYSTEMS

The City of Del Mar charges water connection fees for the provision of potable water service. Part of the fee is a pass-through system capacity charge levied by the San Diego County Water Authority (SDCWA) for each new or upgraded water meter installed. The rate of the fee is based on the water meter size.

Consistent with the California Fire Code (CFC) adopted by the City of Del Mar, all new buildings and all structures which undergo a significant remodel and/or addition are required to install a fire suppression sprinkler system. In some cases, the installation of residential fire sprinklers may require additional standby water service capacity, necessitating an increase of the meter size to serve the residence from a meter less than one inch in size to a meter of one inch in size. In accordance with SDCWA Ordinance No. 2008-1, it is the City's policy that when a water meter for a single-family residential property is required to provide standby capacity to serve a fire sprinkler system, the capacity charges may be determined based on the water meter size necessary to serve the residence without consideration of the additional size necessary to provide a required fire sprinkler standby capacity. **However, please note that this exemption provision does not apply to meters greater than one inch in size.**

The attached exemption form provides the mechanism by which a property owner may request that the Capacity Charge for a new or upgraded water meter be based on the size of the minimally required water meter for the development, without factoring in the added capacity to serve a required fire sprinkler system. To request a waiver, the property owner or authorized representative, must provide a copy of the development plans and a prepared waiver form to the City's Building Services Division, a function provided by True North Compliance (TNC) Services. TNC operates from the Del Mar City Hall located at 1050 Camino del Mar. TNC representatives will review the plans for a determination of the minimal water meter size necessary to meet California Building Code Standards for the type of development proposed, not including the capacity to serve a required fire sprinkler system. Using the same form, TNC representatives, acting as the City's Fire Department designee, will also affirm the necessity of a fire sprinkler system for the project. The completed form may then be submitted to the Del Mar Finance Department for processing.

Please note that if a property owner chooses to install amenities that trigger water service demands exceeding those that would be required to serve the type of development proposed, or to install a larger sized water meter for potential future needs, the option to request a lower Capacity Charge shall not be applicable. Note: To qualify for the SDCWA exemption, all provisions of the SDCWA Ordinance 2008-01 must be verified by representative(s) of the Del Mar Fire Department and/or Del Mar Building Division (acting as designee for the Fire Marshal) **prior to beginning construction**. Verification is provided by the City's Building Services Division, which operates under contract with True North Compliance (TNC) Services from Del Mar City Hall at 1050 Camino del Mar (phone 858-375-9514 or email building@delmar.ca.us). **This exemption provision does not apply to meters greater than one inch in size.**

This form must be accompanied by domestic water hydraulic calculations for the proposed project. Domestic water demand calculations shall be prepared by a licensed Professional Engineer or licensed plumbing contractor. Domestic water demands shall be based on hydraulic calculations using the California Plumbing Code Section 610 and Appendix A. A \$90.00 fee is required for this review, to be paid upon submittal.

2. Commodity Charge: *Cap customized for each Customer*****

- For single family residential users, the bimonthly commodity/volume charge will be based on winter water usage subject to the limitations of the sewer cap which is set annually each July 1. The sewer cap will be derived using 100% of the water usage for the lowest billing period (two months) during the wet winter months, October through April. If that calculation yields a number less than eight (8) units, the cap will be set at eight units.
- Each billing period the single family residential customer sewer commodity charge will be calculated by using 100% of the water used during that billing period by the single family commodity rate in effect. If the 100% calculation yields a water usage amount that exceeds the individual customer's cap, the customer will be billed for the cap amount. The cap will not apply in calculating the commodity charge for residential customers who have installed sub-meters or irrigation meters where household use without irrigation can be calculated.

Planning Your Project

From backyard cleanups to new construction, Waste Management has the right solution for your project. Before you start, decide the following:

- What type(s) and quantity of materials will you be generating (general trash, recycling, construction and demolition debris)?
- How long will the project take to complete?
- Are you required to comply with CALGreen mandates, which require recycling or salvaging 65% of your project's construction and demolition debris?

Ordering Your Service

- Review the Temporary Container Reference Guide on the reverse side of this page for available container types and sizes.
- Make a note of your specific service requirements, such as project location, container placement, size of container(s) needed and frequency of service.
- Remember that recycling, yard trimmings, construction and demolition debris and trash must be separate from each other, so more than one container may be required for your project.
- Contact Waste Management's Customer Service at (858) 452-9810 to place your order.

Completing Your Project

- Place your materials in the appropriate container(s), loading heavy items first and spreading the load evenly, careful not to overload the containers.
- All materials must fit securely inside the container, allowing for the lid to be closed on dumpsters, or level full on roll-offs to allow for the container to be tarped.
- Do not dispose of any hazardous waste materials, such as paint, oil, chemicals, tires, batteries, hot ash, florescent tubes, electronic waste or medical waste.

Construction and Demolition (C&D) Recycling Requirements
