

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-12

RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DEL MAR DECLARING A LOCAL EMERGENCY RELATED TO THE CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19); AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO OBTAIN ANY AND ALL LOCAL, STATE AND FEDERAL AID TO ASSIST WITH ADDRESSING THE LOCAL EMERGENCY AND MAKE PURCHASES, AS NEEDED, UP TO \$50,000 TO ADDRESS THE EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, there exists the COVID-19 virus, which represents a serious public health threat; and

WHEREAS, on January 30, 2020, United States Secretary Alex M. Azar II declared a Public Health Emergency for the United States to aid in the nation's health care community in responding to the COVID-19 virus; and

WHEREAS, on February 14, 2020, the San Diego County Health Officer declared a Local Health Emergency as a result of the COVID-19 virus; which was subsequently ratified by the Board of Supervisors on February 19, 2020; and

WHEREAS, on March 4, 2020, the State of California declared a State of Emergency as a result of the COVID-19 virus; and

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2020, the President of the United States declared a national emergency as a result of the COVID-19 virus; and

WHEREAS, Government Code Section 8630 and Del Mar Municipal Code Chapter 2.52 authorize the City of Del Mar to proclaim a Local Emergency when such events occur as defined by Government Code Section 8558(c), including epidemic such as the COVID-19 virus.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Del Mar that a Local Emergency exists based on the following findings:

1. The COVID-19 virus presents a condition of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property within the City of Del Mar; and
2. The COVID-19 virus may be transmitted through contact with exposed persons and through "community spread"; and
3. These conditions are likely to be beyond the normal capacity and control of the services, personnel, equipment, facilities, and resources of the City of Del Mar; and
4. City staff have taken and continue to take appropriate actions to meet the conditions presented by the COVID-19 virus.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the City Council, based on the facts and circumstances set forth above and the foregoing declaration of Local Emergency, as follows:

1. That the City Manager, also acting in the capacity of Director of Emergency Services for the City, or their designee, is directed and authorized to address any and all impacts and conditions caused by the COVID-19 virus and to obtain any and all assistance from local, county, state or federal agencies, including but not limited to aid and assistance pursuant to the California Disaster Assistance Act ("CDAA").
2. That the City Manager is also hereby authorized to make purchases of supplies, equipment, or contractual services in an amount up to \$50,000 in order to address the COVID-19 emergency.
3. That during the continued existence of this Local Emergency the powers, functions, and duties of the emergency organization of this City shall be those provided by state law and by the ordinances, resolutions, and orders of this City.
4. That, to the extent permitted under state law, the Local Emergency shall continue to exist until its termination is proclaimed by the City Council, which shall be done at the earliest possible date that conditions warrant.
