SUBJECT: Presentation by North County Transit District on Right-of-Way Fencing Proposal

REQUESTED ACTION/RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council receive an informational presentation from North County Transit District's (NCTD) consultant on the completed engineering design and viewshed analysis for NCTD's right-of-way fencing proposal and provide comments to City staff to submit as feedback to NCTD.

DISCUSSION/ANALYSIS:

Representatives from NCTD's consultant team will attend the Del Mar City Council meeting to provide an informational presentation on the engineering design work for NCTD's right-of-way fencing project and visual impact analysis. The planned presentation materials are anticipated to be posted to this web page prior to the Council meeting.

The purpose of the presentation is for the Council to receive information about the engineering design work and viewshed analysis that was completed by NCTD's consultant and to ask questions. Comments and feedback on the proposal should be directed to City staff so that information can be compiled and shared with NCTD, as part of ongoing collaborative negotiations between the City of Del Mar, NCTD, and California Coastal Commission staff related to NCTD's fencing proposal.
