It has been an honor to serve as your Councilmember for 4 years. I have listened to residents' concerns and pursued our shared goals. Our Council successes include:

- Stopped railroad fencing on Del Mar's Upper Bluff coastal trail;
- Established financial viability for affordable housing at the Fairgrounds;
- Launched utility undergrounding pilot project to remove 10 poles
 - Crest Canyon and Stratford Court designs underway;

Defended our adopted Sea Level Rise Plan without Managed Retreat;

- Gained State approval for \$300 million to relocate the railroad tracks;
- Received \$3.5 million from the County to replace Camino Del Mar Bridge;
- Minimized SANDAG's Bluff Stabilization project to stop decapitation of the Bluff;

- Fighting for local control of our land use development.
