*Compliance with the C&D requirements is voluntary for residential remodel projects which do not increase the building's conditioned area, volume, or size.

FORMS OF COMPLIANCE:

1. I plan on using the City's Franchised Hauler, EDCO. All EDCO invoices, weight tickets, and C&D Demolition Diversion Certificates shall be provided to the Building Official prior to final inspection. Please make sure to request all invoices, weight tickets, and C&D certificates when setting up service or when taking material to an EDCO facility. Please note that a third-party hauler may not be utilized in the City of Del Mar.
2. I plan on self-hauling my construction waste and have provided my estimated recycling rate in table 1 (continue to page 2 of this form). All disposal, recycling, and re-use receipts (including material weight) shall be provided to the Building Official prior to final inspection in order to demonstrate 65% diversion of construction material from the landfill.
3. Construction waste shall not exceed 2 lbs. per sf. of area. All disposal receipts shall be provided to the Building Official prior to final inspection which demonstrates that the total amount of waste does not exceed the allowable waste in order to meet this exemption as calculated below. (This option not applicable for most construction projects.)*

Waste Management Plan Certification

Non-hazardous construction waste generated during this project shall be recycled and/or salvaged for re-use at a minimum of 65% per CalGreen requirements. I understand that I must retain all waste, recycling, or re-use receipts which demonstrate quantities of materials taken for disposal, recycling, or reuse to provide to the Building Department to show compliance prior to final inspection. Failure to comply may result in a penalty pursuant to DMMC 23.70.070. I certify that the information provided herein, to the best of my knowledge, is true and correct. I understand that if I do not meet the minimum required construction and demolition diversion rate that I am subject to penalties as defined in DMMC 23.70.070 up to and including a fine of \$1,000.

Percentage to be Re-Used or Recycled 67 %

Formula:

Total Re-used or Recycled ÷ (Total Combined Waste) x 100 = % Re-Used or Recycled

Example: $5370 \div (2700 + 5370) \times 100 = 67\%$ Re-Used or Recycled

Since 67% exceeds the minimum requirement of 65%, this example plan complies.

Final receipts shall show compliance with DMMC 23.70 in that non-hazardous construction waste generated during the project was recycled and/or salvaged for re-use at a minimum of 65% per CalGreen requirements.

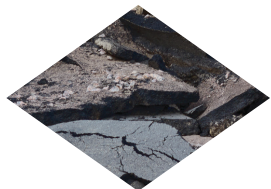

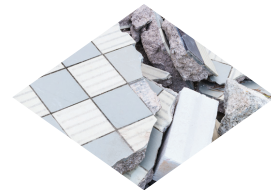

Mixed Construction & Demolition Recycling at EDCO

Did you know about 25% of waste in California is construction and demolition (C&D) debris? Common C&D materials include drywall, cardboard, lumber, metal, rock and asphalt. Many of these materials can be reused or recycled, therefore, prolonging our supply of natural resources and saving valuable landfill space.

C&D debris can be a significant portion of a jurisdiction's waste stream, and diverting it from landfills can help jurisdictions achieve and maintain their diversion goals established by AB 939 and SB 1383. Most C&D debris that is recovered and recycled can be marketed domestically to end-users who in turn process the material into new products.

When requested, EDCO will provide a C&D diversion certificate to show compliance with CalGreen's 65% diversion requirements.

Containers are available for construction/renovation projects, weekly scheduled service, or for temporary use. Roll offs come in different sizes to handle various types of debris. A 40-yard roll off is the right choice for large quantities of yard waste, but rock or concrete must be collected into a smaller, 15-yard, "lowboy" container. Please refer to the box descriptions below for basic dimensions of available containers.

Dimensions: appx. 22 ft. x 8 ft. x 4 ft.

- Roofing Projects: medium jobs
- Landscape Material: tree branches, bushes, grass
- Trash



10-Yard "Mini" Roll-Off Box:

Dimensions: appx. 10 ft. x 7 ft. x 4 ft.

Load Weight Limit:

Maximum legal weight not to exceed 2 tons

Best Uses:

- Great for jobs that don't have room for the longer roll-off box.
- Small Cleanup Projects



15-Yard Roll-Off Box:

Dimensions: appx. 16 ft. x 8 ft. x 3 ½ ft.

Load Weight Limit:

Maximum legal weight not to exceed 10 tons

Best Uses:

- Heavy Construction Debris: rock, brick, clay/ concrete roof tiles, dirt



3 Cubic Yard Temporary-Use Dumpster (T-Bin):

Dimensions: appx. 6 ft. x 3.5 ft. x 4 ft.

Load Weight Limit:

Maximum weight not to exceed 800 lbs.

Best Uses:

- Small cleanup projects.
- A 3-cubic-yard dumpster will hold approximately the same amount of debris as 20 standard trash cans.
