

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

Del Mar Bluffs and Beaches

Starting in **mid-April**, construction crews will begin drainage improvements and stabilization work along the Del Mar bluffs and beaches. This work is necessary to prevent the bluffs from eroding and ensure the safety of train passengers and residents.

During this time, crews will demolish an aging concrete drain along the bluff near **12th Street** and replace it with a more efficient drainage system that runs under the railroad tracks to an outlet on the beach. These improvements will enhance drainage and help prevent flooding in the area.

Crews will also reinforce the seawalls at the base of the bluffs. Beachgoers should expect increased construction traffic along the beach between **Seagrove Park and North Torrey Pines Beach** through **fall 2025**. This work is necessary to stabilize sections of the existing bluffs that have experienced erosion. For your safety, please don't go into the construction zone—this could be dangerous for you and the workers.

Note: Construction schedules are subject to change.
